Palm oil is a type of edible vegetable oil that is derived from the palm fruit, mainly grown in Africa & Asia, but also now in North and South America, with 85% of all palm oil globally produced and exported from Indonesia & Malaysia.

The most popular form is vegetable oil. It is used in everything from food products to detergents to cosmetics and increasingly... biofuel.

Worldwide demand for palm oil is expected to double by 2050 to 240 million tons. This rapid demand comes at the expense of tropical forests, which form critical habitats for a large number of endangered species, including Orangutans. It also impacts soil erosion, air pollution, water pollution and climate change.


